

**Work plan for visiting professor:**

1. To teach at least one course with a 60-hour workload (compulsory or optional) for the Masters and PhD courses of the Graduate Program in Statistics;
2. To teach at least one transversal training course with a 15-hour workload for the Masters and PhD courses of the Graduate Program in Bioinformatics, open to other courses in the area of Biological Sciences and the UFMG community;
3. Development of research projects with professors of the Graduate Program in Statistics on lines of research already in progress;
4. Development of research projects with professors of the Graduate Program in Statistics on new lines of research, preferably in areas of the knowledge frontier;
5. Collaboration on research projects with professors of the Graduate Program in Bioinformatics;
6. To coordinate sessions of thematic lectures in areas of collaborative research with other professors.
